A full calendar of events is available to all members, whether you're an experienced boatie or a novice. For those who like to race, our regular Red Top Race series gives sailing opportunities, or for more casual or social events, join in with the regular cruising some members take to the spectacular waterways around this charming region, as well as regular fun events held at the Club.

Hard Stands: A waiting list exists for hard stands within the Club grounds. If you wish to go on it, you must give written notice. All hard stand allocations are made by the committee only, and no private arrangements are permitted. CBBC does not have wet berths in the Marina.

Social functions at the Club are a good way to meet other members, and particularly so at the barbeques held at the Clubrooms on the first Sunday of every month. To help keep prices down, we ask all members to bring along a family sized salad or sweet each month, for everyone to share. Our Sand Bar is open whenever a member of the committee is in attendance, with very reasonable prices for drinks.
